Membership fees are due on April 1st 2010 and can be submitted by post or paid over the bar in the clubhouse. Credit and/or Debit Card payments can also be made using the PDQ machine.

Notes on membership categories

ALL members will be required to join one of the following basic categories :-

1. Life Membership will be available to any member over the age of 60 years on payment of ten times the annual membership rate at the time of becoming a life member.
2. Friend of E.C.R.C., covering a five year period, will be available to any member on payment of five times the annual rate at the time of joining discounted to reflect extended period.
3. Centenary Membership will be available until March 31st 2011 to existing Centenary members at a cost of £60.00 pa. This category allows the named member the free use of the pavilion for one private function annually.
3. Social Membership allows applicant access to all clubhouse facilities. A reduced rate is available for the spouses/partners of social members without loss of privileges.
4. Senior Membership is only available to those receiving State Retirement Pension.
If partners/spouses of senior members also receive State Retirement Pension a reduced rate is available without loss of privileges. For spouses under State Retirement Pension Social Spouse Membership rates will apply.
5. Junior Membership is available to all those members above the age of 7yrs and under the age of 18yrs at 31st March 2010.
6. Student membership is available to any young person actively engaged in full time education.
7. Membership for anyone under the age of 7yrs at 31st March 2010 will be free BUT their details must be registered with the Membership Secretary to comply with the club's constitution.
8. Job seekers/Income Support Membership will be available to those members who are in receipt of these benefits.
9. Bowling Match Day Membership will be available to current members of the Bowling Club and then only on match days.
10. Folk group occasional membership will be available for Folk Club nights only.
11. NEW APPLICANTS ONLY must have their application form countersigned by two existing Members as Proposers.
12. Membership and Till ID cards will ONLY be issued to the nominated person(s) on the application form after the subscription has been received. Till ID cards can only be used by the members to whom they are issued and are not transferrable.

Member participating in sporting categories are required to pay additional fees

- 1 Senior Cricketers members will be charged an additional £40.00.
- 2 Taverner members will be charged an additional £25.00.
- 3 Junior/Student cricket members playing for senior teams will be charged an additional £20.00.
4. Junior cricket members representing junior team eg U15s will be required to pay any additional £5.00 playing fees.
5. Junior cricketers wishing to receive coaching from qualified staff will be required to pay an additional charge of £35.00 in advance of the first session. No additional fees will be charged for each session and a pro-rata rate will be charged for late starters.
6. Senior Rounders players will be charged an additional £ 6.00 .
7. Junior/Student Rounders players will be charged an additional £4.00
8. All Running Club members will be charged an additional £6.00.
- 9 Job seekers/Income Support Members will be charged half the respective rate for sporting membership.
